Our contracts have included services provided in the Continental United States (CONUS) and Outside the Continental United States (OCONUS). CNO companies provide workforce staffing solutions for medical, behavioral health, administrative and technical requirements. We excel in delivering pre-qualified medical and allied healthcare providers, licensed and credentialed to industry standards and all Federal and State regulations to support Military Treatment Facilities and remote clinics.
